Jeanette opened the meeting by establishing why the sub committee has been set up.

We discussed that a questionnaire would need to be produced, which Jeanette has offered to do.

We discussed how we might be able to circulate the questionnaire. The only full proof way of ensuring no one is missed would be to drop one into every household.

We discussed what age groups we would target and thought that possible 2 questionnaires may be required, one for the 6-12 year olds and one for 13-16's. This needs discussing further.

To ensure that the questionnaires are returned, Su suggested that we state on the questionnaire that once completed and returned (by a certain date), their questionnaire would be entered into a draw with a chance to win a prize.

- Grass verge to be replaced along the Fambridge Road to allow for a wider and safer footpath.
- Opening up the village hall for more activities i.e. youth club
- The larger football pitch to be available to use for all children in the village not just the football team.
